Job Title: Swim Instructor/Lifeguard

Part Time/Seasonal

Primary Responsibilities

- Maintain constant surveillance of patrons in the pool; act immediately and appropriately to secure the safety of patrons in the event of an emergency.
- Provide emergency care and treatment as required until the arrival of emergency medical services.
- Teach small groups of students basic swimming techniques with the highest standard of safety
- Communicate with Co-Instructor before, after and during lessons to provide the best possible instruction to each class
- Present professional appearance and attitude at all times and maintain a high standard of customer service
- Perform miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

Education and Training

Six months to 1-year experience directly related to the duties and responsibilities specified. First Aid, AED/CPR Certified; Current certification as Lifeguard by the recognized source of training.
